The Brunelleschi Lifetime Achievement Award is the highest individual honor DBIA bestows. It is presented to individuals who have made significant contributions to the design and construction industry through outstanding leadership and innovation in the advancement of design-build project delivery. Recipients of this award have exhibited originality, vision, and breadth over the course of their professional life, with **25 years or more** of strong and well-documented commitment to design-build project delivery. Nominations are due no later than July 10, 2020.

- In **300 words** or less, describe the nominee's earliest demonstration of this commitment (include the year as part of the description).
- Provide **three additional examples** of service and/or work product over nominee's career that have contributed to either the advancement of design-build, and/or the application of Design-Build Done Right® principles and practices? Each should be **150 words or less**.

- **List of any additional industry awards or honors the nominee has received over the last ten (10) years, if applicable.**
- Provide at least three testimonials (Including contact information) from others in the industry related to this nominee. Testimonials should be 300 words or less and should represent various industry perspectives (i.e, owner, designer, contractor, legal, etc.)
